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GSX-R1000 (07-08) CHECK ENGINE LIGHT DISCONNECT INSTRUCTIONS


When installing a Brock's Performance exhaust system on a Suzuki GSX-R1000 the following procedure must be followed to prevent illumination of the check engine light.

For additional installation support please refer to the OEM service manual.

Instructions:

Note: The "bowtie" plate included with the exhaust system is NOT required if this procedure is followed.

- Disconnect the cables from the OEM exhaust control valve actuator (EXCVA) located under the seat/gas tank on the right side of the bike. DO NOT unplug the EXCVA electrical connectors from the wiring harness. Do not remove the EXCVA unit.
- 2. Remove the OEM exhaust system, exhaust control valve, and cables.
- 3. Install your Brock's Performance Exhaust System.
- 4. Locate the Black wire with Brown tracer (with two green dots) on the right side ECU (ECM) coupler.
- 5. Cut the wire approximately 1.5 inches (40 mm) back from the coupler and insulate both ends with electrical tape.
- 6. The motorcycle may now be operated in a normal fashion without the check engine light illuminated.



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
