# **NINJA 300 (13-17) & NINJA 250R (08-12) WINDOW LINK™ KIT INSTRUCTIONS**

The fully adjustable Window Link™ Kit for the Kawasaki Ninja 250R/300 allows for quick and easy seatheight adjustments from lowered (-1.00") to slammed (-3.5") without removing the links from the bike.

## **Check Package Contents:**

### The Package Contents Include:

- 1. Two (2) Left Hand Link Ends
- 2. Two (2) Right Hand Link Ends
- 3. Two (2) Left Hand Jam Nuts
- 4. Two (2) Right Hand Jam Nuts
- 5. Two (2) Adjustment Rods
- 6. Two (2) Washers
- 7. One (1) Adjustment Consistency Instructions (not shown)





For additional installation support please refer to the OEM service manual.

#### **Removal Instructions:**

- 1. Properly support the bike and place a scissor jack (or similar type) beneath the rocker arm. Insert a small piece of wood between the jack and rocker to prevent metal-on-metal contact. Raise the bike so the rear wheel is just off the ground (Fig 1).
- 2. Remove the nuts securing the OEM links.
- 3. Remove the OEM links and bolts from the bike (Fig 2).


**Note:** Bolts should be easy to remove/install. If pressure is still on the bolts, adjust the scissor jack up/down until the bolts slide free.

## **Installation Instructions:**

- 4. For ease of adjustment set the length of the Window Links before installing. Follow supplemental <u>adjustment</u> instructions for details.
- 5. Install a Window Link to the right side first. Slide the bolts though the link to hold in place.
- 6. Install the supplied washer over the bolts on the left side (Fig 3).
- 7. Install a Window Link to the left side on top of the washers (Fig 4).
- 8. Secure the Window Links with the OEM nuts hand tight.
- 9. Lower the bike so the full weight is on the rear suspension.
- 10. Torque mounting bolts and nuts to 44 lb-ft (59 N·m).
- 11. Adjust the Window Links to the desired ride height (Longer = Lower).
- 12. Check for proper suspension travel and clearance around any moving parts.

Warning: It is imperative to ensure the Window Links are adjusted within .010" (.25mm) of each other and the Adjustment Rod threads can be seen in <u>all</u> four (4) windows. Please follow the <u>Window Link Adjustment Consistency</u> supplemental instructions for details.









Caution: Chassis adjustments can alter the handling characteristics of any machine, and a lowered vehicle is more likely to experience obstacle and/or cornering clearance contact problems.
